



Fort Loramie Curbside Recycling Program



Proper recycling is very important to the success of our curbside recycling program. Please read the list below of acceptable recycling items and how they are to be placed in the bin. Any unacceptable items will be left in the recycling bin.

Acceptable	Newspapers, Newspaper Inserts, Magazines & Cardboard	Aluminum Beverage & Steel Food Cans	Glass Jars/Bottles (food & beverage only) Clear-Green-Brown	Plastic Bottle & Jugs with #1 and #2 recycling symbol
How to Place in Recycling Bin	Newspapers, inserts and magazines must be bundled or placed in brown paper bags. (Use plastic bags on rainy days.) Cardboard must be flattened and cut down NO BIGGER than 2' x 3'.	Rinse thoroughly, remove lids and discard. Flatten to save space.	Rinse thoroughly. Remove any lids or corks and discard.	Rinse thoroughly. Remove lids and discard. Flatten to save space and keep them from blowing away.
Not Acceptable	NO phonebooks, books, office/school paper, junk mail, envelopes or other paper items.	NO paint cans, scrap metal, pots/pans, spray cans or other metal items.	NO light bulbs, dishes, window glass, mirrors, candle jars or other glass items.	NO Styrofoam, plastic bags, automotive fluid containers, buckets, tubs, lids, trays, deli containers or plastics #3 through #7.

Recycling Bins are available at the Town Office.

Curbside recyclable pickup is on Thursday.

Note: The curbside collection program is for Residential Recycling only.
